Visitor Sign-In Procedures:

Starting the first day of school we are continuing our visitor identification process. When you come to visit Ivy Hill School please ring the doorbell. Everyone will be greeted and asked to share the reason for their visit prior to entering the school. If you are planning to stay and volunteer within the school building, we will need to scan your government issued identification card. The system will check your ID against the Statewide Sex Offender Database and the Statewide Murder and Violent Offender Against Youth Database. The process only takes a few seconds and increases the safety of all our students. We will only need to scan your identification card once per year. I truly appreciate your patience and cooperation with this continued procedure.
