Award District Site Improvement Projects

Purpose: to improve the existing playground structure, play lot and site surrounding the Westgate play area. This project was outlined in the 2018 Capital Improvement as previously presented to the Board. This project will install a poured in place rubber surface, similar to what's at Olive, Ivy and Windsor. That and a few other adjustments will improve ADA accessibility to the playground area.

In April of 2018, the District successfully piloted an online address verification system that will eliminate the need for the majority of families to bring paper copies of personal documents to the school during the residency process of registration. This online verification system will give the community a convenient way to submit required residency information during registration, as well as reduce the workload on building administrative assistants and provide a thorough way for the District to address questions of residency and residency investigations.

Recommendations for 2018-2019:

Returning Families: (1) Returning families will have an online verification process of their addresses in spring/summer. (2) Require families who can not be electronically verified to bring in documentation during the first week of August.

New Families: (1) Prove residency using three-document system (only "Part A" document will be scanned and uploaded to InfoSnap). (2) Families will only have to prove residency at one of their students' schools. (3) CLEAR (online verification system) address verification will occur within 30 days of enrollment.
