## Flooring work at Minor School \*APPROVED\*

Within the consent agenda, Mrs. Ann Buch was approved to be the new Principal of Westgate Elementary School.

The Board of Education approved amending the District's contract with the Cook County Bus Company for the 2019-2020 school year due to the change in the level of service as a result of the stay-at-home orders.

Because our Rand School building does not operate as a public school, the internet/WAN connections to the building can't be covered through the Consortium approved during the last board meeting. Based on this, we need to continue a separate agreement for these services for Rand to maintain our building automation system. We are recommending the Board approve the 3-year agreement for Rand with Comcast for \$546/month for these services.

The scope of work covered in this package relates to the removal of a failing unused masonry chimney at Westgate Elementary School and the restoration of several small roof sections at Westgate. The Board of Education awarded the roofing and masonry scope to DCG Roofing Services in the amount of \$47,860 including Base Bid.

The work approved here is for the 2nd floor at Minor School, currently occupied by District 25's tenant, NSSEO. Though the flooring is currently not a hazard, it is becoming evident that it will not be able to be reliably maintained in the near future.

The ACM flooring abatement scope was awarded to Valor Technologies in the amount of \$52,200. Also, the new flooring installation scope was awarded to Consolidated Commercial Flooring of Chicago in the amount of \$118,395.53 under the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing contract.
