Music for Youth Agreement

APPROVED

Music for Youth is a stringed-instrument program that has been partially funded by District 25 for over 40 years. The proposed agreement reflects annual increases based on CPI-U for the next 3 years. The fiscal impact is \$313,579 over 3 years.

Consolidated District Plan

APPROVED

Earlier this calendar year, Illinois State Board of Education launched the "IL ePlan", which attempts to consolidate and streamline the federal grant management process. This plan removes questions and reporting requirements from multiple, individual federal grant applications and consolidates them all under one plan in order to make the grant application process more efficient for school districts.

It is required by the state that this plan be presented and approved by the Board.
