This presentation covered the Kindergarten Individual Development Survey (KIDS) assessment, The Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC), the Illinois Science Assessment (ISA), and the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment.

"We have a strong curriculum that challenges all of our students. We do not believe in relying on just one data point, but looking at them as a whole to help measure growth." - Dr. Eric Olson on Assessment

KIDS - State percent of readiness: 49%, District 25 percent of readiness: 69%

PARCC Reading - State percent proficiency score: 37%, District 25 percent proficiency: 56%

PARCC Math - State percent proficiency score: 31%, District 25 percent proficiency: 53%

ISA 5th grade - State percent proficiency score: 52.6%, District 25 percent proficiency score: 74.9%

ISA 8th grade - State percent proficiency score: 57.7%, District 25 percent proficiency score: 78.4%
