- Begin with remote learning with a goal Goal is to transition to a hybrid (in-person & remote) learning platform.
- Survey data helped to inform our goals for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Working with AH Park District & childcare partners, brainstorming on how they can help.
- Updated Calendar:
 - August 24-31 | Staff Work Days
 - September 1 | First day for students
- · Transition Model of instruction | Allowing to move slower but more purposeful through stages
 - Step 1 | All Students Remote Learning
 - Step 2 | Remote Learning with Gradual Return
 - Step 3 | Hybrid Model, AM/PM or 2 days on site, 2 days off site.
 - Step 4 | All Students, In-Person
 - Can move to this step even in Illinois does not move to phase 5
- Transition Advisory Committee: parents, teachers, administrators, Board of Education members, and medical professionals
 - Will meet every Tuesday at 4 pm and assess possible return to school

- Remote Learning | An Enriched Model
 - Teachers to work from their classrooms
 - IEP, 504, & EL services provided remote. Some IEP, OT, and PT would be provided on-site.
