

LEA DETERMINATION

- 1 ISBE completes LEA Determination annually for all Illinois School Districts.
- The Individuals with Disabilities Act 2004 (IDEA 2004) requires that all states make determinations about school district performance regarding the provision of special education and related services for students with disabilities
- 3 ISBE has determined that Arlington Heights School District 25 **Meets Requirements** in implementing one or more of the IDEA requirements.
- 4 ISBE indicates AHSD 25 may voluntarily utilize their Universal, Tier 1 support.

Measures the percent of students with IEPS served inside the general education classroom 80% or more of the school day.

bell-to-bell minutes (not
instructional minutes). This
includes the time a student
with a disability spends
during lunch, recess, and
specials.

PROVIDE

Provide professional development around Multi Tiered Systems of Support for students, academically and socially/emotionally.
