

Hi Parents,

This is Officer Veenstra from the Arlington Heights Police Department. I am the School Resource Officer for several schools in Arlington Hts.. Just a couple of safety reminders that will keep traffic moving efficiently and more importantly keep our kids safe.

- 1. Pull up your vehicles as far as you possibly can to drop off your children, allowing the cars behind you room, so that traffic doesn't back up.
- 2. Don't double-park to drop off your kids.
- 3. If you are getting out of your car and walking with your child, please don't park and leave your car in the drop off area.
- 4. Please don't make U-Turns in the drop-off area.
- 5. Let your kids out of the car on the curb side, not in the street.
- 6. On days that have inclement weather, please follow the same rules!
- 7. Some additional State Laws that pertain to areas where parents are dropping off their children.

625 ILCS 5/11-1303 - No Parking

- In front of a public or private driveway.
- Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection.
- Within 30 feet of a STOP sign, YIELD sign or traffic control signal.
- Obey all parking signs near the school
