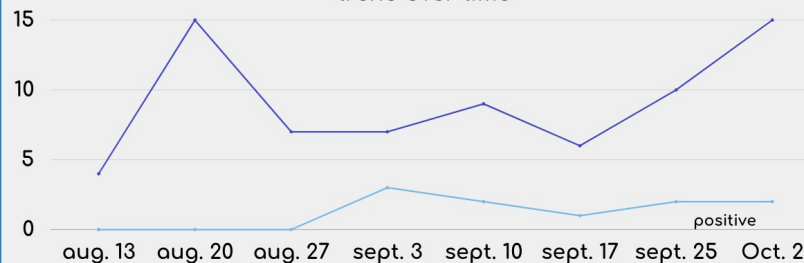

# SHIELD Testing

- Approximately 1,500 enrolled
- 1st & 2<sup>nd</sup> week going very smoothly
  - Thank you to administrators, parent volunteers, and students
  - Challenging for EC and some Kgtn students
  - Takes 2 minutes for middle school; 5-8 for elementary
  - Increased # of workers in 2nd week





# Academy Program

- Early Childhood
- Kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade = 2 days of 20 students
- 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade = 2 days of 24-34 students; 2 days of 40+
  - - check-in to original teacher
  - - split into groups utilizing additional teacher
- 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade





# Lunch

- 3 feet distance to the greatest extent possible is required
- However, changed to 6 feet distance for contact tracing when masks are removed (lunch)
- Modifications
  - Outside where possible
  - Utilizing more spaces
  - Reducing time without masks
