Tutoring Service

- ESSER funds of \$265,780 were designated for tutoring services
- July 1, 2021 through utilized by September 30, 2024 (3 year process)
- The Department of Student Learning is facilitating the process.
 - ✓ Identify staffing
 - ✓ Identify students based on data review from October 11th
 - ✓ Group students by school
 - Notify families of after-school programming
 - Determine if there are additional seats available

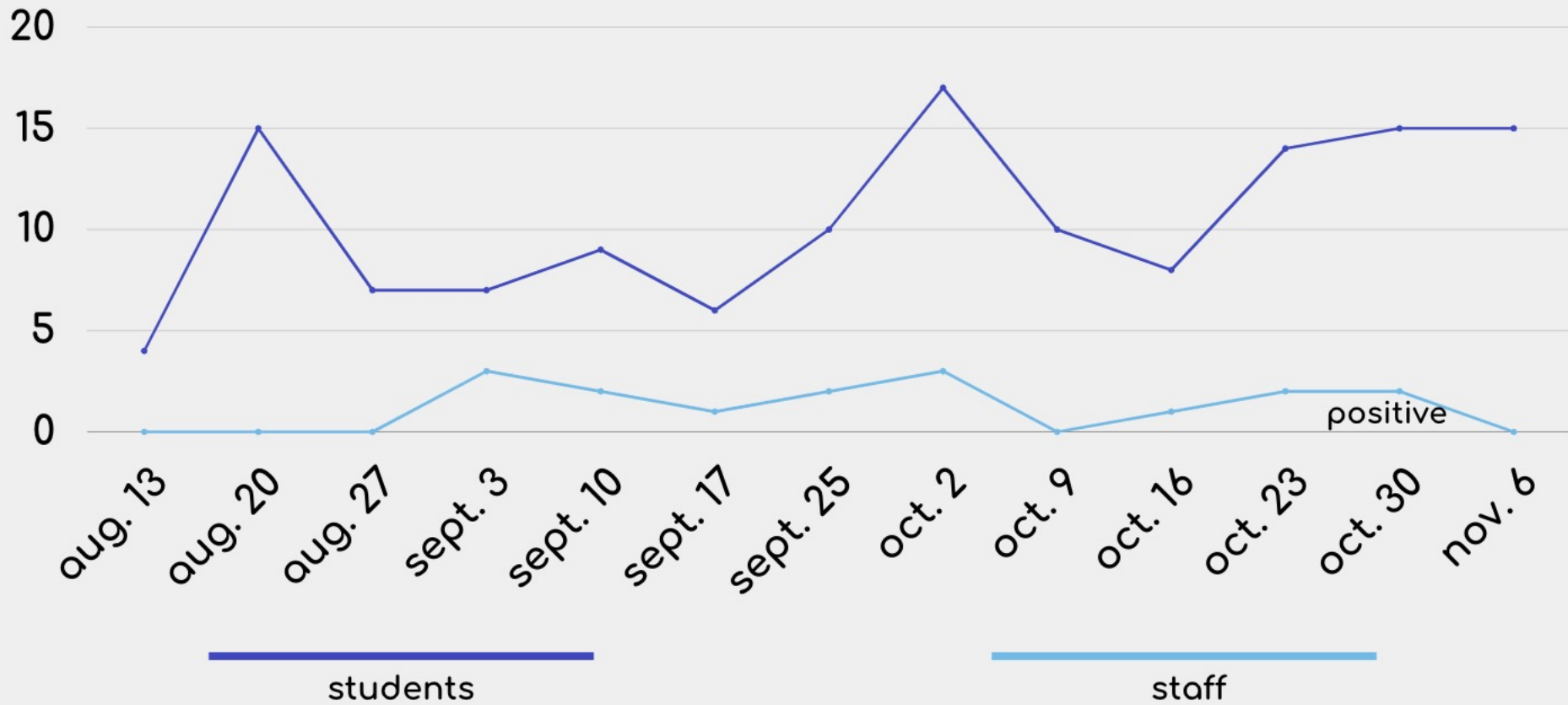

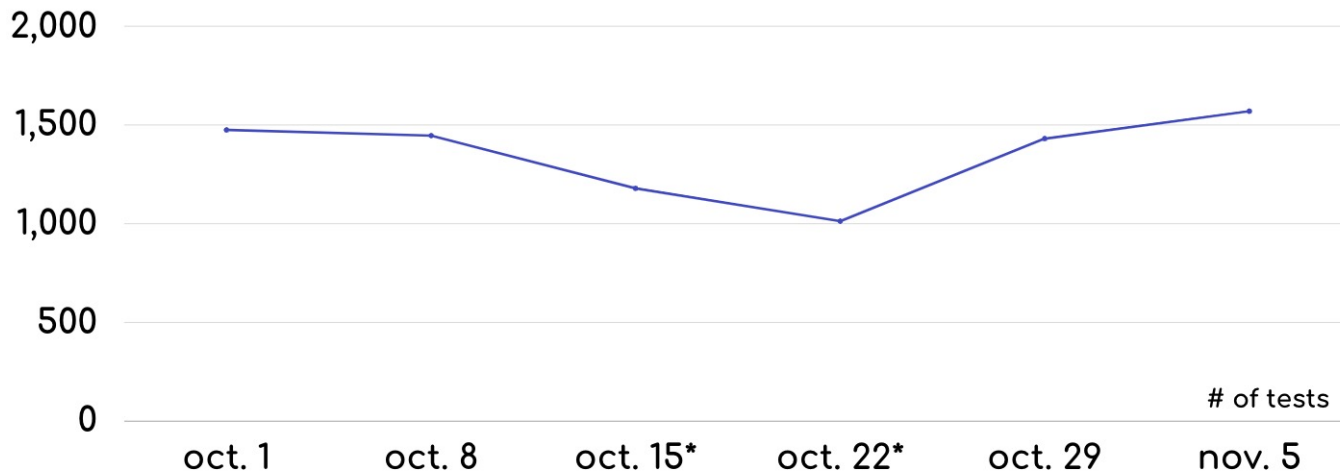

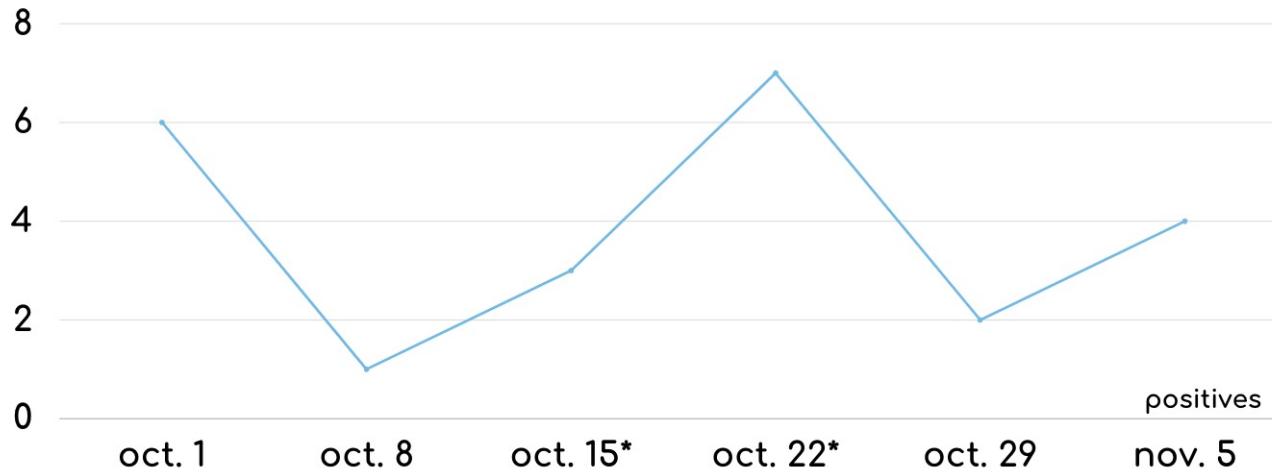

Lunch Arrangements

- All schools have rearranged lunch due to IDPH change in close contact determination
 - 6 feet of spacing without masks
 - Less than 15 minutes of exposure to a positive case without masks
 - Increased supervision
 - Increased space usage
 - Resulting in 0 close contacts from lunch since the modifications were made





Vaccine Clinics

- Host of Pfizer vaccine clinics for students age 5+ with Jewel/Osco
 - *Save the Date* memo on November 2nd
 - Registration opened on November 6th & filled within a few hours
 - November 8th = 578 students
 - November 29th = 2nd vaccination
 - Incredibly well organized, managed, and supported by District 25 nurses, administrators, support staff, and facilities staff
