

STUDENT DATA UPDATE

DATA PRIVACY AS PRIORITY

- It is our legal and ethical obligation to protect students and their data.
- Personally Identifiable Information (PII) includes information such as name, DOB, address, grades, ID numbers, etc.



CURRENT AREAS OF FOCUS

- Web page with approved platforms and tools include privacy policies and terms of service.
 - Reviewed twice per year for updates
- Educational websites & web-based tools information in handbook and online.
- Limited personally identifiable information (PII) in student accounts.

CURRENT AREAS OF FOCUS

- Information provided to staff regarding available systems and platforms.
 - Review of subscriptions and applications through Tech Facilitators.
- Maintaining access and monitoring controls.
- Updated data breach protocol.



STUDENT ONLINE PERSONAL PROTECTION ACT (SOPPA)

- Updated Student Online Personal Protection Act, will go into effect July 2021.
- ▶ The significant changes made to this law impact:
 - School Districts (BOE Policy 7:345)
 - The Illinois State Board of Education
 - Educational technology vendors who plan on working with these entities



KEY CONCEPTS AND EXPECTATIONS

- An operator is any 3rd party (website, resource, service, software, app). Operators host, process, gather, and maintain data from parents and students.
- Schools and Operators may only collect information for school related purposes.



KEY CONCEPTS AND EXPECTATIONS CONT.

- The district must:
 - Have a written agreement with operators that deals with personally identifiable information (PII).
 - Post a variety of information on website including data review procedures, vendor agreements, data shared, and data breaches.



CURRENT SOPPA RELATED ACTIVITIES

- Recent adoption of BOE policies (7:345)
 - Updated data breach procedures and responsibilities
- Training with LTC (Learning and Technology Center of Illinois)
- Member of SPDC (Student Data Privacy Consortium)
- Ongoing collection of data agreements with operators



CURRENT SOPPA RELATED ACTIVITIES

- Coordinating with legal teams and other districts
- Meetings and communications with:
 - Cabinet | Administrative team | Tech facilitators | Staff
- Utilizing LearnPlatform for both staff and public facing information to provide updated and required information


