ACCEPTABLE MASKS








Gaiters Are Approved Only If 2 or More Layers of Fabric are Covering the nose and mouth
















Are made of fabric that makes it hard to breathe, for example, vinyl



Have exhalation valves or vents which allow virus particles to escape



Are prioritized for healthcare workers, including N95 respirators


Have two or more layers of washable, breathable fabric



Completely cover your nose and



Fit snugly against the sides of your face and don't have gaps



N95 respirators for staff are not required nor provided unless for an approved medical or another approved accommodation. Backup cloth and disposable face coverings are available at the main office if needed. Individuals are

responsible for cleaning and care of their face coverings. UNACCEPTABLE

MASKS WITH VENTS, MESH, or FACE SHIELDS

Why? Masks with vents/exhalation valves allow unfiltered exhaled air to escape. This is an unacceptable form of source control as a universal mask while on school property. Face shields cannot be worn without a mask unless a documented medical accommodation is provided. Updated: 8/13/21 R1
