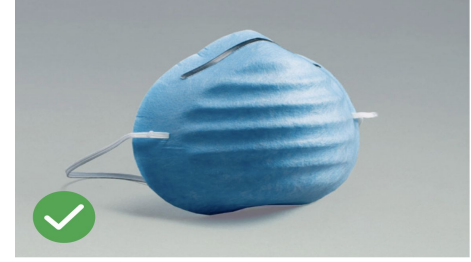




Acceptable Face Covering Masks for Visitors, Staff and Students

All visitors, staff and students are required to wear a mask while on school property unless medically approved with the appropriate accommodations.

ACCEPTABLE MASKS



Gaiters Are Approved Only If 2 or More Layers of Fabric are Covering the nose and mouth

DO choose masks that		DO NOT choose masks that	
	Have two or more layers of washable, breathable fabric		Are made of fabric that makes it hard to breathe, for example, vinyl
	Completely cover your nose and mouth		Have exhalation valves or vents which allow virus particles to escape
	Fit snugly against the sides of your face and don't have gaps		Are prioritized for healthcare workers, including N95 respirators
	Have a nose wire to prevent air from leaking out of the top of the mask		

N95 respirators for staff are not required nor provided unless for an approved medical or another approved accommodation. Backup cloth and disposable face coverings are available at the main office if needed. Individuals are responsible for cleaning and care of their face coverings.

UNACCEPTABLE MASKS

MASKS WITH VENTS, MESH, or FACE SHIELDS



Why? Masks with vents/exhalation valves allow unfiltered exhaled air to escape. This is an unacceptable form of source control as a universal mask while on school property. Face shields cannot be worn without a mask unless a documented medical accommodation is provided.
