Tonight the District 25 Board of Education voted not to implement an adaptive pause. This means that all students and staff will continue in the <u>Step 3 | Hybrid Learning Model</u> next week.

Thomas Middle School will remain remote with a return to the Step 3 | Hybrid Learning Model on Tuesday, December 15th.

What this means moving forward

- We will continue to monitor our internal numbers and pay attention to the guidance from our various health organizations.
- It is our intention to shift to our *Step 4* | *In-Person or Remote Learning* once the <u>metrics for full</u> in-person learning are met.
- We will continue to focus on the safety of our students and staff as we move forward with providing engaging instruction and a caring learning environment.
